Number and percentage of pregnant women referred by CHWs who delivered at health facility.	38,340	29,588	<b>77%</b>	From the 83,497 mothers recorded for ANC,4th ANC attendees accounted for 77% of the targeted HF deliveries
Number of IDUs reached through the HIV/AIDS prevention program during the reporting period	3,300	4,083	<b>124%</b>	The additional 5 implementing partners for PWIDs resulted in additional 5 drop-in centers reaching additional 783 PWIDs.
Number of CSWs reached by HIV/AIDS prevention programs during the reporting period	12,250	12,750	<b>104%</b>	The mobile wellness outreaches facilitated target achievement in hard to reach hotspot
Number of MSMs reached by HIV/AIDS prevention programs during the reporting period	2,433	3,730	<b>153%</b>	One MSM network was added as an implementing partner thus increasing the mobilization efforts.
