### SUB-GRANTEE IMPLEMENTATION IN TARGET COUNTIES FOR GLOBAL FUND MALARIA PROJECT GC7 JULY 2024 - JUNE 2027

#### Background information

Amref Health Africa in Kenya is the non-state Principal Recipient (PR) for the GC7 July 2024 to June 2027 Global Fund (GF) Malaria grant. In consultation with Kenya Coordinating Mechanism (KCM) and Ministry of Health, Amref Health Africa in Kenya is requesting for proposals from eligible organisations that will be sub-granted to implement priority components in **three (3) target counties**.

#### Target counties

**Kisii, Kakamega and Kericho counties.**

#### Eligible organizations

Eligible organizations include NGOs and CSOs that are non-profit organizations and operate independently from the state and from the private for-profit sector. These include national and local NGOs, community-based organizations (CBOs), faith-based organizations (FBOs), affected-community led organizations and professional associations.

\*Note that Global Fund Grant is not for profit making and any applicant cannot use the grant funds to make profit\*

#### Scope of work

The successful applicant will be required to support implementation of community malaria activities in the proposed areas/counties of operation as detailed in the application form.
